intricate conservatory, and the *leitmotif* of blue and primrose stained glass panels which Soane repeated up and down the Manor. In homage to Soane, the art deco 1930s Gallery building incorporates striking stained glass roof lights, flooding the Gallery with natural light.

For this reason, sponsoring a pane of glass is the perfect way to restore Soane's legacy for generations to come, and give the place he loved a new heart, inspiring visitors with world class architecture, art and design.




## The impact of your support
